GLENDALE OFFERS RESIDENTS INFORMATION ON ABANDONED SHOPPING CARTS IN NEIGHBORHOODS

Glendale, Ariz. – Have you ever wondered how to report a stray shopping cart found in your neighborhood?

The state of Arizona mandates the laws regarding shopping carts for retailers, and the city of Glendale does not handle the retrieval of such carts or any part of the process.

There is a local company, however, that many retail stores contract with to carry out these services. Arizona Cart Retrieval Company handles cart retrieval for many merchants all over the Valley, including statewide locations of Safeway, Fry's, Smart & Final, Albertson's, Family Dollar, Party City, Trader Joe's, Sprouts, Sunflower Farmers Markets, in addition to most outlets of Wal-Mart, Walgreen's, Basha's, Food City and AJ's Fine Foods.

To report an abandoned cart, residents can contact Arizona Cart Retrieval by calling 1-800-THE-CART. Leave a detailed message including the exact location of the cart including major cross streets, the name of the store the cart belongs to as well as a phone number to provide them with additional information if necessary.
